Chinook School Division believes that maximum use of school facilities should occur both in serving the needs of students and other members of the commuity. The principal may levy a rental charge to approved groups for the purpose of covering operational expense and additional maintenance costs. Fees are suggested rates and exceptional circumstances may require different charges at the discretion of the Principal. All charges except for ancilliary charges are deemed as School Generated Funds. Ancilliary charges incurred by Chinook shall be charged back to the respective school. Those ancilliary charges shall be defined as:
