The SPS Student Leadership Committee has been fundraising all year to host a colour run to acknowledge Indigenous Peoples Day on Friday, June 21, 2024. There will be orange colour stations set up along the way to acknowledge the impacts of the residential school system, and posters will be set up along the run with information about the Calls to Action about child welfare and education from the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada.

- The run will take place from 2:00 - 3:00 pm and will begin and end on the Shaunavon Public School playground. The run will begin with a staggered start, with the lower grades starting the run first.
- All SPS students are invited to run, but have the option to choose not to participate.
- Students are welcome to invite **one** family member to join them in the run.
- The SLC has fundraised to cover the costs of the powdered colour.
 - ◆ The SLC is selling optional, plain white t-shirts for the run for the cost of \$5.00
 - ◆ T-shirt orders must be in by **May 27th** (runners can continue to sign up until June 14)
- Runners are encouraged to wear sunglasses or goggles to help keep the powdered colour out of their eyes.
- The colour is made with food-grade cornstarch, baking soda, and FD&C approved food and cosmetic dyes. The colour is non-toxic and washable, however it is still a good idea to wear clothes and shoes that can be stained.
- There will be an optional sprinkler / cool down area on the playground that runners may choose to run through at the end of their run.
 - ◆ **Please ensure runners have a change of clothes for the end of the day, especially if they are taking the bus home.**

- Build a butterfly feeding station.
- Play with Slime outdoors
- Fill the paddling pool with glow sticks and bubbles
- Make a rainbow garden. Sew some annual flower seeds in bands to make a flower power rainbow.
- Try spotting the international space station.
- Make a pinata
- Have water fight.
- Buy something new for the kids garden and build it together.
- Use the dressing up box or a puppet show and let the kids put on a show
- Make salt dough decorations
- Craft a sparkling fairy jar
- Make a den in the garden with sticks or sheets
- Collect flowers and make a daisy chain
- Make a toad abode
- Hand casting on the beach
- Sand volcano
- Rock pool at the beach
- Go to the beach and hunt for shells
- Design and make your own obstacle course
- Tag. Take some flash lights and play torch tag. You could use glow stick bands too.
- Play badminton in the garden
- Cut and arrange some flowers
- Make friendship bracelets
- Design your own stepping stone.
- Have a beach bbq and toast marshmallows.
- Visit the beach and help the environment by having a litter pick up or fill a jar with nurdles. The little plastic beads that are filling our oceans.
- Pick strawberries and make an Eton mess
- Make your own Pizza
- Toast Marshmallows
- Make fruit kebab skewers with chocolate dipping sauce
- Go on a bug hunt
- Use some chalk to create a paving stone art gallery
- Make a flower garland or curtain.
- Design a garden collage
- Make some glow in the dark bubbles
- Have a sunflower growing competition
- Make a mini pond pot
- Design a bird bath for your feathered friends.
- Pavement chalk
- Make a rainbow gard
- Stargaze at night. Try to plot a constellation.
- Make a fairy or dino garden
- Design a Clay pot person
- Make a list for scavenger hunt
- Have a game of roundels
- Take the children out to choose their own autumn bulbs for planting
- Reuse some old toys as new planters or art in the garden
- Put double-sided sticky tape on some card and see how many nature colours the children can spot and collect on a walk outside
- Plant an edible garden
- Go leaf or bark rubbing
- Forage fruit and make a smoothy
- Make a miniature garden
- Grow edible flowers to decorate your plate.
- Build a scarecrow
- Plant up a pizza garden
- Have a water fight
- Personalise the playhouse
- Blow bubbles
- Design an obstacle course for your kids and their friends. Have medals or stickers to give to the winner.
- Make natural paint brushes.
- Nature treasure hunt/colour hunt.
- Recycle some soda bottle plastic by making beautiful butterflies for the garden
- Make a wildlife maze for bugs and race your snail, beetle or woodlouse through it.
- Learn a tennis ball game
- Make a video diary for a relative or friend
- Paint something outdoors.
- Have a BBQ/ party
- Collect some seeds and make your own seed bombs
- Make a bug spotter sheet and search for bugs
- Press some flowers
- Have a shell treasure hunt and start a collection
- Collect shells at the beach and paint a funny character.
- Go out for pizza or ice cream
- Have a day out at an animal farm or zoo
- Go berry picking
- Have a picnic somewhere new
- Join the rock revolution!
- Use black card and some glue and catch a spider web.
- Have a picnic under a tree, explore the tree and find out whats living there.
- Make a flower fairy picture
- Forage for wild raspberries and make some cordial to drink.
- Start a nature journal and add something new every day. We draw pictures, add photos, stick in pressed flowers or feathers etc. Your use imagination.
- Let the kids make a scavenger hunt together for a familiar park or area.
- Build a bird house
- Use foraged berries to make ice lollies
- Build a bug hotel
- Jump in puddles
- Have a snail hunt. Mark the shells carefully then race them. Who ever crosses the line first wins.
- Make a pebble pet
- Look for space rocks. Use a strong magnet to rub through the soil or sand and the small round shapes you collect could be magnetic iron or nickel micro meteorites. So exciting
- Stone stacking competition
- Make a sling shot with a strong forked stick and a chunky rubber band. Place some balls or other light objects on job roll tubes as targets. Never aim at people.
- Go to a 5 a side pitch and play ball.
- Learn to skip
- Learn to roller-skate
- Go for a bike ride
- Go for a ride on your scooter
- Insect catching or pond dipping
- Use some bamboo canes, netting and pruning to make a camouflaged bird spotting den.
- Paint a stone hide a stone find a stone. There are special groups almost everywhere now where you find a pebble and pair on a picture of your choosing and hide it somewhere outdoors.
- Then when your out try looking for others. If you find one take a picture and pop it onto your local group page and the re-hide it. Brilliant for kids.
- Make a tic tac toe board from stones.
